AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V.Ravindhar, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Assistant Government Pleader attached to the office of Advocate General for Respondent Nos. 1 to 7, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 8 & 9 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Issue notice to respondent Nos.8 and 9, returnable in two weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent Nos.8 and 9 by registered post with acknowledgement due and file proof of service into the Registry.

List the matter on 06.05.2026.

The 6th respondent-Station House Officer, Machavaram Police Station, is directed to produce the corpus, namely, Smt. Bolla Mounika and Master Rudved Rana Mendu , who is a minor, before the Court on the next date of hearing i.e., on 06.05.2026.
